MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

Education / Experience / Certification

- ◆ A bachelor's degree from a four-year accredited college or university in psychology, social work, sociology or related human services degree.
- ◆ Child Welfare Certification Required
- ◆ Two (2) years of Child Welfare Related experience preferred
- ◆ A minimum of two (2) years of practical field experience preferred

General Purpose of Job (Full job description provided upon interview)

To assist Child Protective Investigators (CPIs) with requests for services intended to prevent removal of children from their families. Evaluate referrals for front-end family preservation type services; assign and staff cases to the appropriate provider; troubleshoot barriers to services; analyze trends and needs; review requests for ancillary paid services needed throughout the investigation; participate in case staffing's as needed, as well as contract monitoring activities. This position will also serve as back up for the ITR (Intake Triage & Referral) Specialist, who coordinates and schedules district-wide staffing's between DCF and the Case Management Organizations (CMOs) for case transfer.

Certificates, License, Registrations, backgrounds, drug screens, Etc.

- ◆ Valid driver's license, clean driver's check, and proof of insurance is required
- ◆ Children's Network participates in E-Verify
- ◆ Criminal background screening (FBI/FDLE and Local Law Enforcement) and Abuse Registry Check
- ◆ Drug Screening is a requirement
