<p>1 Will proposals that include an annual budget exceeding the expected annual funding amount of \$2,211,228.00 be considered or disqualified under this ITN?</p> <p>a. If such proposals are considered, how, if at all, will a budget that exceeds the expected annual funding affect proposal scoring?</p>	<p>Submitting a budget that exceeds the anticipated annual funding amount for this contract (approximately \$2,211,228.00) is not an automatic disqualifier under this ITN.</p> <p>For scoring details, please refer to the ITN posted on the website at https://childrensnetworkhillsborough.org/procurement</p>
<p>2 Is the expected annual funding amount of \$2,211,228.00 inclusive of both direct program expense and administrative costs?</p>	Yes
<p>3 Will any portion of the contract funding be paid based on a performance-based methodology?</p> <p>a. If so, will such performance-based funding be in addition to the expected fixed price funding in the amount of \$2,211,228.00?</p>	Contracts awarded under this ITN will not utilize a performance-based funding methodology. Contracts awarded through this ITN will be a fixed-price (unit cost) contract. A service unit is one service month.
<p>4 Will compensation levels exceeding those identified in the table on page 5 of the ITN be permitted where such compensation was approved by CNHC in prior contract/budget years?</p>	Respondents are required to submit a comprehensive budget detailing all service-related expenses for the delivery of services.
<p>5 Are offerors required to propose additional performance measures beyond those specified in the chart on page 19 of the ITN?</p>	No, this is not a requirement of offerors.



6	May an offeror submit proposals for consideration under both ITN – CNHC CPA/PLACEMENT-FY26-29 and ITN – CNHC-CPA-FY26-29?	Offerors may submit proposals for any CNHC solicitation, provided the offeror meets the specified criteria.
7	Can a respondent that is working to obtain a CPA license submit a proposal?	No, eligible respondents must hold a current Child Placing Agency (CPA) License from the Florida Department of Children and Families.
